LCA Saints Scholars Fund

Nearly 20% of our students receive tuition assistance. As part of the Fund for LCA, donors can now support student tuition assistance through the Lakewood Catholic Academy Saints Scholars Fund. The Saints Scholars Fund will be expended each year, enabling LCA to provide tuition assistance to a student(s) who has demonstrated financial need.

Requirements to establish a named Saints Scholars Fund are as follows:

- \$2,500 annual gift for three consecutive years representing one-half of the full cost of educating one student. Total gift after three years is \$7,500.
- \$5,000 annual gift for three consecutive years representing the full cost of educating one student. Total gift after three years is \$15,000.

As a donor to the Saints Scholars Fund, you can witness a life being changed before your eyes during the course of the three year commitment. Your student will be designated as a **Saints Scholar** bearing your family name. (e.g. Jones Family Saints Scholar).
