- I. The meeting was called to order with a prayer at 7:12 p.m.
- II. Minutes from the September 27, 2005 general membership meeting were reviewed, corrected, and approved. **m/s/v**
- III. Treasurer's Report –  
Lori Piscitello reported the current balance in the LOFT account. There are two large bills outstanding, spirit wear and the magazine sale.
- IV. Principal's Report –

- V. Report of Standing Committees –

Parents have to sign students in and out. There were over eight volunteers to chaperone and 15 including set up. The DJ said what nice kids we have. Expenses are estimated at \$600 and income was \$470. The balance of the budget will be used for the spring dance.
  - Fall Festival – Jean Spackman reported that there are 163 pre-paid children and we will be taking admission at the door. Room parents are calling to ask for donations of pop, candy, and cake walk items. Volunteers are still needed for the crafts. There will be a haunted stage, games, crafts, pictures, and a cake walk. Will be decorating the cafeteria on Thursday from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
