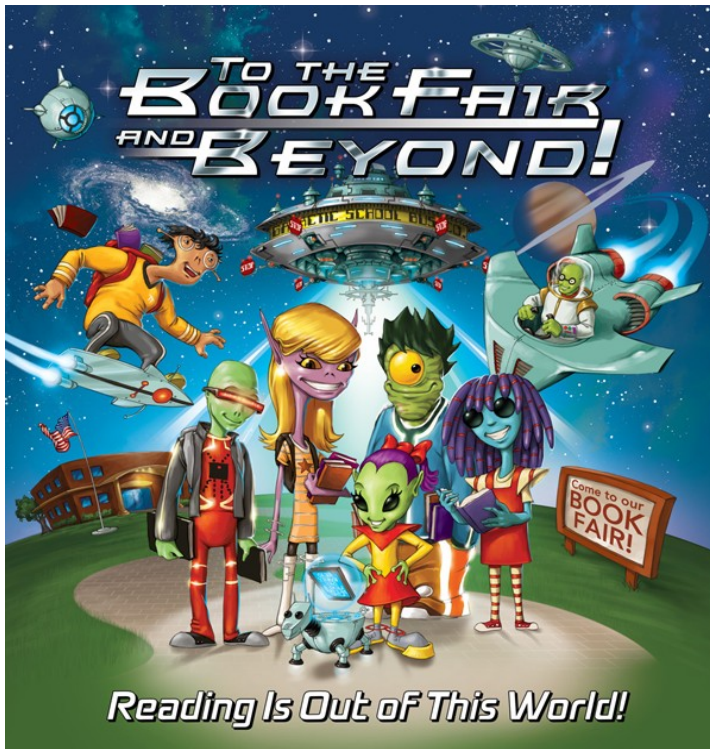


# WELCOME
