2008-09 BASKETBALL INFORMATION

Deadline OF OCTOBER 17, 2007 for REGULAR BASKETBALL (gr. 4-8). NO EXCEPTIONS—only because of team need!!!!

PHYSICALS. All athletes are required to have a current physical form signed by their doctor, dated less than a year ago, on file with LCA CYO Athletics. Athletes may not practice or play until a current form is on file with LCAAB. Blank physical forms are available in the LCA main office or on Tim Rinehart's (Athletic Director) porch, 1629 Robinwood Avenue.

Turn in forms to the LCA OFFICE: Sport Participant form, Emergency Info form, Athlete's Code of Conduct, Volunteer form, Physical form and associated fees.

VOLUNTEERS are what make CYO sports possible. Every family is expected to help at least once during regular season, and once during the LCA Basketball tournament. These events enable LCAAB to pay for each team to participate in outside tournaments and for gym rental for practices, games and tournaments not held at LCA. Your child's coach will be asking for your commitment.

COACHES & ASST COACHES are especially important. When we have enough coaches, we are able to keep team rosters smaller, allowing for more instruction and playing time. CYO does require new coaches to attend a one day program which includes coach's orientation, VIRTUS and fingerprinting. CYO coach's program is paid for by LCAAB.

FEES. Your child will not receive a uniform until all fees have been paid, and previous uniforms have been returned. If fees present a financial hardship, speak directly to Tim Rinehart, Athletic Director. All calls are kept confidential.
