instruments are not worth repairing and need to be replaced. We hope to use the fundraiser proceeds to overhaul worn instruments and to purchase new equipment. In addition to instrument repairs, past fundraisers have paid for expensive specialty instruments like the tuba, timpani, orchestral tubular chimes, drum set, gong, and baritone saxophone. These instruments are too expensive for individuals to purchase and are generally owned by schools. We strive to maintain top quality equipment and current music to provide our students the best possible music education. We continue to offer scholarships on various instruments so that the program remains affordable to all.

To meet these needs, our program conducts an Annual Band Patron Drive to raise much needed funds for our program. To raise funds this year, we plan to sell Band Patron memberships for the next two weeks - now until December 3.

Our band patrons will be listed in the Christmas and Spring Concert programs. There are five levels of contribution, ranging from \$25 to \$1,000. The \$55 level will pay for one new band arrangement. The \$1,000 St. Cecilia level will provide new spring concert music for all bands.



Ski Club Sign-Up Deadline Is Approaching...

Ski Club starts January 9th and ends February 20th. Each Friday from 4:15 until 10:00 p.m. we will take Lakefront Lines coach bus to and from Boston Mills (BM) and Brandywine (BW). We will go to BM the first five Fridays and then to BW the final two Fridays. Pricing includes a total of seven sessions at BM/BW with four hours of slope time each visit, five one-hour lessons, and four \$10 value passes that can be used towards lift tickets or snow tubing anytime and can be shared with a friend. Students in grades four through eight, as well as LCA alumni, can now register for the club.

All current and future skiers and snowboarders can **register and pay online here**. Our club login is lakewoodcath and our club password is member. (Do not include the period!)

The cost to equipment owners is \$159. The cost to equipment

renters is \$223.05. (Renters: your value passes will include equipment rental) A separate \$100 check will need to be sent in for bussing. We only have 100 seats available. After we reach capacity, we will create a wait list to perhaps add a third bus. Make checks payable to LCA, place in an envelope addressed to Hollie Nejad/ Ski Advisor, and send it to school. Students that have not submitted the bussing payment by December 5th will not be permitted to ride the bus.

Registration ends December 20th. Once we receive a final roster of all snow enthusiasts, we will send out a group reminder and further details on pick-up and drop-off. All skiers and snowboarders are required to wear a helmet when participating in Ski Club. If you mention that you are part of the LCA Ski Club, Geiger's in Lakewood and Village in North Olmsted are offering discounts. Geiger's is offering 20% off helmets and Village is offering 20% off goggles and kids' clothing and \$10 off helmets. Village asks that you bring in a flier to receive the discount.
